Motion by Marucco, seconded by Likes, to approve ORDINANCE 15-632, entitled AN ORDINANCE FOR THE VILLAGE OF STONINGTON, CHRISTIAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS TO SELL A USED GENERATOR TO THE CITY OF ASSUMPTION, CHRISTIAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS. Motion passed with a 6-0 vote.

President Paulek opened two bids for mowing. Bids were from Cut Above Lawn Care in the amount of \$298.00 per visit and Adcock Mowing in the amount of \$179.00 per visit. **Motion** made by Dowdy, seconded by Thomason, to approve Adcock Mowing in the amount of \$179.00 per visit for the summer of 2015. **Motion** passed by a 6-0 vote.

<u>Engineer's Report</u>: Engineer Bainbridge updated the Board on the raw water line grant. Phase 1 is complete and discussed the final payment to C & S Companies, Inc. in the amount of \$58,410.25.

Engineer Bainbridge discussed with the Board Phase 2 for a new well and an aerator.
