The Committee at Large meeting was held on Tuesday, November 19, 2024, at 6:00 p.m. at the Village Hall.

The Meeting was called to order by President Bruce Dowdy with the following Members present:

President Dowdy discussed the current health insurance policy. He reported that Travis Peden and Billy Brunk are the only two employees currently on the health insurance policy and a quick decision had to be made by October 31, 2024, to switch policies. The policy was switched that increased the premium by 18.5%. Since there was no time for a discussion about the switch of policies and to inform the employees, the Board decided that Billy Brunk should not pay more than Travis Peden which is 18 cents an hour. The Board discussed whether to continue to provide health insurance to current and future employees. After much discussion it was decided to table it for more discussions.

President Dowdy brought up the discussion of Chapter 6. Traffic, Article 5. Abandoned, Stolen, Inoperable Motor Vehicles. After much Board discussion, the Board decided to make the following changes which will be in an Ordinance form and to be passed at the December 2, 2024 regular Board meeting:

6.505 Penalties: Any person violating any of the provisions of this Chapter shall, upon conviction, be fined not less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each separate offense, and a separate offense shall be deemed to occur on each day fourteen (14) days after the initial fine is issued and can be re-fined again every seven (7) days thereafter on or during which a violation is deemed to exist or continues.

With no further business coming before the Board, a motion was made by Callan, seconded by Kuntzman, to adjourn the meeting at 7:22 p.m. Motion passed by all "Yea" votes.
